Sealed Bids for constructing the Wahoo Creek Water Reclamation Facility (WRF) Sludge Dewatering Upgrades for Newnan Utilities will be received at the Wahoo Creek Administration Building located at 315 Millard Farmer Industrial Boulevard, Newnan, Georgia 30263 until 2:00 PM local time on Thursday September 9, 2021, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read.

Project Description: The work to be performed shall consist of furnishing all materials, tools and equipment and performing all labor necessary for constructing the Wahoo Creek WRF Sludge Dewatering Upgrades as set forth in the bid, as shown on the drawings and as specified. The project generally consists of the following major components of work and appurtenances:

- a. New 2.2 meter belt press and appurtenances;
- b. Modifications to existing Wahoo Creek WRF Dewatering Building and Sludge Pump Station;
- c. Upgrades to the existing WRF Reuse Water System;
- d. Miscellaneous piping upgrades and modifications; and
- e. Electrical and instrumentation upgrades and modifications.

Bids shall contain prices, in words and figures, for the work bid on. All bids shall be submitted on the bid form included in the Contract documents. All bids must be accompanied by a certified check, or a bid bond of a reputable bonding company authorized to do business in the State of Georgia, in an amount equal to at least ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the bid. The bid bond shall be prepared on the form of the bid bond attached to the Contract Documents or a surety company's standard bid bond, duly executed by the Bidder as principal and having as surety thereon a surety company licensed to do business in the State of Georgia and listed in the latest issue of the United States Treasury Circular 570. Upon the proper execution of the agreement and required bonds, the checks or bid bonds of all bidders will be returned to them.

A contract performance bond and payment bond, each in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the agreement amount, will be required of the successful bidder.
