WHY ARE GREASE TRAPS REQUIRED?

Grease blockages in sewer lines are the major cause of sewer overflows and other unpleasant issues.

By direction of The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD), Newnan Utilities, your sewer service provider, is required to have a grease management program. The goal of the program is to reduce the amount of grease entering the sewer system by collecting the grease at the source through traps, and disposing of it properly.

When you properly maintain your grease trap, you play an important role in protecting the sewer system, public health, and the environment.

WHO DO I CONTACT ABOUT MY GREASE TRAP?

Newnan Utilities contracts with **J&L Backflow** to manage its grease management program. *J&L Backflow is your primary point of contact. Contact info can be found on the front of this card.* All charges related to your grease trap(s) will appear on your monthly Newnan Utilities statement.
